Overview

Site 6 was originally part of a 93 acre lot purchased by Thomas Brightman Sr. and his brother Joseph Brightman in 1775. Thomas bought out his brother's half in 1777. In 1785, Thomas purchased an additional 30 acres adjacent to 93 acre lot. Part of Site 6 was on the 30 acre lot as well. Thomas built a house on the 30 acres next to the road. The remains of cellar can still be seen. He built and operated a shingle mill until his death 1843. The property was used primarily for timber harvesting. Thomas Sr., his wife, and his son Joseph are buried in a small family plot on the property. His son Thomas Jr. inherited the property and subdivided it between his two sons. The property was subsequently sold off. Lawton Foster bought 40 acres of property in 1868 including the Brightman house. Lawton Foster acquired his father, Jonathan Foster, sawmill in 1868. The sawmill was down stream from the Brightman's mill. Lawton likely bought the property for its timber. In later years, Lawton used part of the property for pasturage. 1939 aerial photo shows a pasture on part of the property.



Cairn in its present state appears to be an Open/Closed design with a secondary cairn on the ground attached to the side of the base stone. However, note the configuration of the small tree trunk. Cairn has a small tree growing out of its base on top of the boulder. The tree's trunk goes horizontally for about 6" before going vertically upwards. That shows the tree's trunk grew under a stone. The stones on the ground fell off the top of the boulder. The large stones were likely a short one stone high wall to contain the low end of the cairn. A few Open End/Closed End cairns have a variant in that they have a single stone high wall enclosing the open end. Most Open End/Closed End cairns lack this feature and have a full open end.

NOTE: Structures #26 through #60 were photographed during a tour of the property which was part of Hopkinton Planning Board's review of a subdivision application. The pace of the tour did not allow for detailed documentation or the placement of rulers for scale. Most do not have measurements. A single structure # was assigned by Steve DiMarzo Jr. to many of the photos or groups of photos. However, many of photos have two or three cairns in the same photo. In these cases, the structures were assigned "A", "B", etc (for example 26A, 26B). References to the specific photo number are also included to aid identification.

GPS coordinates were overlaid onto the field photos by an application on the IPad. These coordinates are the position of the photographer at the time of the photo and are any where from a few feet to 10 feet away from the structure. This is well within the normal +/- accuracy distance for consumer GPS units and therefore has no significant impact on mapping of the structures.

A number of these structures were documented on subsequent trips resulting in some structures having multiple numbers assigned to them.







Vertical walled, poor workmanship note stacking of small stones on corner (photo 031 right side) (this side has partial collapse), some sections have large flat stones slab-like, another section has large flat-faced chunky boulder type stones flowing into yet another section with medium sized flat-faced chunky boulder type stones. There is a wide mix of stone types in this cairn.

Feature: Tunnel underneath cairn (photo 036 & 041)

Side 1 has an oblong stone in an upright position wedged into the top of an open space between the two bedrock sections. The open space is the equivalent of a natural split in a boulder. (Photo 041)

Side 2 has a thin flat slab across the top of the open space between the two bedrock sections. On top of the slab is a chunky boulder. (Photo 036)

Side 2 has a thin stone slab in a vertical position which is quite noticeable among the chunky stones on that side (photo 038). It also stands out because all other stone slabs used in this cairn were placed in the horizontal position and laid flat.

A low narrow open tunnel going from side to side was intentionally created underneath this cairn. The tunnel is at the apex of a natural V formation created naturally by the bedrock formation.

Ends of Cairn: End "A" large stones flank sides with smaller stones in between, actual end is open and does not have stones, note there is no stone on ground so no stone has fallen out, the open end is an intentional feature, inside. (photo 035) End "B" is vertical walled with stacking on one corner, it is primarily built on the ground with the exception of an extra large rectangular block on the bottom, end B is half the width of the main cairn (photo 040), it has smaller stones than the main cairn (photo 038), one corner is made up of stacked medium size stones which has caused partial collapse (poor workmanship).

Discussion

This cairn is a split stone cairn with two major features: a tunnel = spirit portal underneath the cairn and an open-end on one end of the cairn with a closed-end on opposite end of cairn

Two flatted topped boulders touch each other at an angle. The angle created a natural V shaped indentation on each side. One side was filled with stone to create a continuous side wall. The second side's V was left open. This may be a feature such as a spirit portal. At the vertex of the V there is a large square block of stone on top. It stands out and therefore is a feature. On top of the boulder large flat thick stones with a few cobbles mixed in were arranged in single layer surrounding the edge. The large stones hold in smaller interior stones. The whole top of the boulder is covered with loose stones.

This is combination cairn. The closed-end has a vertical walled side. The open-end has loose stone fill. The base stone, the boulder has one end resting on the top of a ground level boulder. On top of the smaller ground level boulder is a large stone and two small stones that abut the larger base stone. This creates a two-in-one cairn.

This is an extra-large open /closed cairn. Its two side walls appear to have been extended beyond its original configuration to extend the life of the cairn. The extension does not have stone fill in it like the original section. The size of the cairn suggests it was a community cairn where everyone who attended the ceremony made a stone offering. The fact the extension was not filled with stone suggests that it was abandoned while still in active use.

#63 Two Segments of Wide Walls and a long length of exposed bedrock

There is a long length of exposed bedrock along the top of the knoll. On one end one of the longest length of wide wall extends outward perpendicular to the bedrock. About at the end, there is a gap and then there is a shorter segment of wide wall that parallels the bedrock. This creates a semienclosed area in a rectangular shape. There are some large boulders in the interior so it is not clear if the structure is a ceremonial enclosure or two long vertical walled cairns. The longest wide wall has stone fill as noted by a collapsed section.

#64 Snake Effigy & Wall C

The structure is a stone wall one and half stones wide. It is neatly constructed with flat sides, chinking between the larger stones, a semi-flat face. There is a mix of boulder and slabs in the wall. Most stones have a flat face that was intentionally faced outward.

At the west end a large triangular shaped stone was set on top of another stone. The triangular stone is horizontal with its pointed end oriented away from the wall. The triangular stone and its base each have a build up of lichen indicating they are contemporary with each other. The configuration is that of a snake.

The triangular stone was split using the plug and feather method. This dates it to 1820 or later.



The opposite end has a finished end. That is it is squared-off neatly on three sides with flat surfaces.

Wall: 2' to 2 1/2' H x 18" W x ? L

Note: The wall construction is different from the Brightman cemetery wall. The cemetery wall does not have chinking and it is clearly one stone wide with numerous small holes.

#66 Enclosure?

A stone wall was erected incorporating several ex-large boulders. One is on the extreme end. A second larger boulder is midway. The opposite end of the wall is attached to a line of naturally split outcrop boulders which has a small cairn on top of its end. There are stones scattered in a line that form a curved enclosed area. More large boulders are seen within the interior of the structure. There is a symbolic manmade wall segment. Is it part of an unfinished enclosure? More work is needed to answer this question.



#66A Vertical Wall Cairn with Depression Features Attached to Outcrop

One is about 6" x 12" and may be a portal feature. The second is elongated and shallow. The edges of the depression are defined by walls 2-3 stones wide.


